<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Federal).		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> This fund was created by the State Board of Control January 10, 1973, under the provisions of Government Code section 17201. Fund was abolished per Government Code section 13306(b) on December 17, 2012.
