<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>GAAP Basis</u> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>Legal Basis</u> Nongovernmental/Trust and Agency Funds - Federal (N)	
<u>Purpose</u> The purpose of the fund will be to develop and administer a program through which local agencies would receive grants to encourage the collection of used oil products.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> California Integrated Waste Management Board/Org 3910		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Money will be transferred from the Petroleum Violation Escrow Account (#853) for grants (Maximum \$1,000,000)		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Grants to local agencies (not to exceed \$75,000 per grant) to encourage establishing public used oil collection projects. These grants will require that 50% of the costs of the project are from other public or private sources. 10% of the amount deposited into the Fund for Administrative costs. Grants cannot be used to replace current funding sources.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Continuously appropriated.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which will be already counted in an always excluded fund, the Petroleum Violation Escrow Account (0853), and should not be double counted; as well as this fund is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Federal).		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 1657, Statutes of 1990 created the Used Oil Collection Demonstration Grant Fund. These funds will be transferred from the Petroleum Violation Escrow Account (#853). Fund abolished per Government Code section 13306(b).
