<b><u>Legal Title</u></b> High Polluter Repair or Removal Account		
<b><u>Legal Citation/Authority</u></b> Chapter 28, Statutes of 1994 Health & Safety Code section 4409(a)		
<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>GAAP Basis</u></b> Fiduciary/Agency Funds	<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>Legal Basis</u></b> Nongovernmental/Trust & Agency Funds - Nonfederal	
<b><u>Purpose</u></b> This account will be used to deposit money received from donations, grants or DMV renewal fees. This fund would be used to establish and implement a program for the repair or replacement high polluters.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Consumer Affairs/ Org 1111		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Portion of DMV registration fees, donations, and grants for certificates of exemption for a new motor vehicles biennial smog inspection.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> The balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to Fund 0582 - High Polluter Repair or Removal Account effective January 1, 1998.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> This fund is available upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <i>Always Excluded</i> --Non governmental cost funds are always excluded from the State Appropriations Limit because the moneys are derived from non-tax revenues. Expenditures from these funds do not represent a cost of government. These funds consist of receipts from the sale of lands, funds created for accounting purposes, fines and penalties or moneys held in trust.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 802, Statutes of 1997 amended this fund and was reclassified and renumbered to Fund 0582/High Polluter Repair or Removal Account, effective January 1, 1998.
