<b><u>Purpose</u></b> Maintains the integrity of the fees collected on behalf of locals and the State Controller's Office, separate from Motor Vehicle Account money.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Motor Vehicles/Org 2740		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Various fees collected pursuant to statute. (County transportation projects fees, traffic congestion and storm water fees, toll evasion penalties, failure to appear/pay fines, freeway emergencies fees, air quality fees, parking penalties, vehicle theft fees, fingerprint ID fees.)		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund. Additionally, in accordance with Vehicle Code section 4772, any remaining balance in the fund from toll evasion penalties shall be transferred to the State Highway Account in the State Transportation Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> This fund is continuously appropriated; however, Government Code section 13340 requires a current Budget Act to maintain the continuous appropriation.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Non-Federal).		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> This fund was established to satisfy collection requirements for the following Vehicle Code sections: <b>Locals Fees: county transportation projects fees (VC 9250.4), traffic congestion and stormwater pollution fees (VC 9250.5),</b> toll evasion penalties (VC 4772), failure to appear/pay fines (VC 14910), freeway emergencies fees (VC 9250.10), air quality fees (VC 9250.11), parking penalties (VC 4762), <b>SCO Fees: vehicle theft fees (VC 9250.14), fingerprint ID fees (VC 9250.19).</b>
