<u>Purpose</u> To provide funding for new program

<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Transfer from General Fund (Initial funding of \$1.5 million)		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 1section 6346, absent any language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Funds are available upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund, which has already been counted in an included fund, the General Fund (0001), and should not be double counted.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> This fund was administratively established based on AB 536. The Governor vetoed the bill so the fund is being abolished in accordance with Government Code 13306(b).
