<b><u>Purpose</u></b> Funds may be expended for capital improvements, land acquisition, and support of the Baldwin Hills Conservancy's operations.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Baldwin Hills Conservancy/Org 3835		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Fees, grants, or other contributions by any public agency, private entity, or person.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Available upon appropriation by the legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> According to Chapter 428 Statutes of 2000, Public Resources Code 32580 this fund will be in effect only until January 1, 2008, unless a later statute is enacted to delete or extend that date. Chapter 178, Statutes of 2007 extended the repeal date to January 1, 2018.
