<b><u>Purpose</u></b> This fund was established to deposit all fees paid by applicants registering for environmental assessor classifications. Fees are assessed to sufficiently meet the costs of application processing, registration, listing and publication, audits, complaints, investigations, disciplinary proceedings, and other activities necessary to administer and implement the environmental assessor registration program.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Toxic Substances Control/ Org 3960		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Fees required by each applicant for registration as an environmental assessor.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not the proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred may become proceeds of taxes.
