<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Fees collected from the owner or developer of an eligible project that elects to use mitigation actions developed and approved by the department pursuant to Fish and Game Code Section 2069.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Money in this fund is continuously appropriated, without regard to fiscal year.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to provide direct services or products to the payers.
