<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To promote equal employment opportunities in hiring and promotion at community college districts in accordance with Education Code section 87100 through 87108.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges/Org 6870		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Money appropriated in the annual Budget Act or transfers from Proposition 98 Community College district apportionments pursuant to Education Code section 87482.7 (b).		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by Legislature		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – The major revenue source is transferred from an included Fund, the General Fund, which has already been counted and should not be double counted. Apportionments from School districts are from the General Fund and the amount to be deposited in Fund 3273 is essentially a transfer from the General Fund.
