<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To pay the state's share of the costs of flood management projects to improve the level of flood protection in the state capital region.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Water Resources/Org 3860		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Transfer from the Flood Protection Account (Fund 6002).		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Available upon appropriation by the legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted or will be counted in an always excluded fund, Flood Protection Account (6002), and should not be double counted; as well as, the funds are derived from a Bond Fund.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> No money deposited in this subaccount may be used to pay the costs incurred in connection with the administration of this article. This fund was established by the passage of Proposition 13 on the March 2000 ballot.
