<u>Legal Citation/Authority</u> Chapter 725, Statutes of 1999 Water Code section 79152		
<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>GAAP Basis</u> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>Legal Basis</u> Nongovernmental/Bond Funds	
<u>Purpose</u> Transfers from the Safe Drinking Water, Clean Water, Watershed Protection, and Flood Protection Bond Fund (Fund 6001) to be allocated to programs specified in the legislation.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Water Resources/Org 3860		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Transfers from the Safe Drinking Water, Clean Water, Watershed Protection, and Flood Protection Bond Fund, loan repayments, and the related interest.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Available upon appropriation by the legislature and continuously appropriated.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted or will be counted in an always excluded fund, Safe Drinking, Clean Water, Watershed Protection, and Flood Protection Bond Fund (6001), and should not be double counted; as well as, the funds are derived from a Bond Fund.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> This fund was established by the passage of Proposition 13 on the March 2000 ballot. There are four programs in this account. Of these programs three are available upon appropriation by the legislature and one, the Groundwater Recharge Facilities Program, is continuously appropriated.
