<u>Purpose</u> Grants for feasibility studies, project design, or the construction of conjunctive use projects on a pilot or operational scale.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Water Resources /Org 3860		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Transfers from the Water Supply, Reliability, and Infrastructure Account.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Available upon appropriation by the legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted or will be counted in an always excluded fund, Water Supply Relief and Infrastructure Account (6024), and should not be double counted; as well as, the funds are derived from a Bond Fund.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> This fund was established by the passage of Proposition 13 on the March 2000 ballot. Not more than 5% of the total amount deposited in the subaccount may be used for feasibility studies.
