<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To make payments or advances to local child support agencies.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Child Support Services / Org 5175		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Moneys transferred from public agencies (returned federal funds) and interest accrued on funds.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Family Code section 17702.5 (d), any moneys remaining in this fund shall be returned to the federal agency that provides federal financial participation to the department.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Section 17702.5 (c) of the Family Code, provides that the moneys in this fund shall be available upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Non-Federal).
