<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>GAAP Basis</u> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>Legal Basis</u> Nongovernmental/Trust & Agency Funds – Non-Federal	
<u>Purpose</u> This fund was created for the purpose of establishing a program under which money received from private gifts and grants would reimburse participating out-of-area pediatric and adult specialty care providers for the cost of care rendered to low-income persons in underserved areas. Included costs are: transportation, facility costs, medical supplies, appliances, and equipment. Compensation for professional services delivered by a participating provider is not an included cost.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development/Org 4140, in consultation with the Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260.		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> This fund will be composed of all private gifts or grants.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Money in this fund will be available for allocation upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Non-Federal).		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> The Health and Safety Code section 127634 that created this fund was repealed on January 1, 2007 by its own terms.
