<u>Legal Title</u> Agricultural Employee Relief Fund		
<u>Legal Citation/Authority</u> Chapter 408, Statutes of 2001 Labor Cod, section 1161		
<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>GAAP Basis</u> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>Legal Basis</u> Nongovernmental/Trust & Agency Funds – Non-Federal	
<u>Purpose</u> To deposit money collected by the Agricultural Labor Relations Board, on behalf of Agricultural employees for monetary relief that the Board orders paid by employers who violate agricultural labor laws. Money collected by the Board will be deposited into this fund if after two years the Board is unable to locate an employee on whose behalf they have collected monetary damages. The Board will act as a trustee of all money deposited into this fund. Money in this fund will be used by the Board to pay employees the unpaid balance of any monetary relief ordered by the Board to be paid by an employer to an employee.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Agricultural Labor Relations Board/Org 7300		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Monetary relief collected by the Agricultural Labor Relations Board.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Money in this fund is continuously appropriated.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Non-Federal).
