<u>Purpose</u> To develop and carry out a statewide plan for better implementation and coordination of immigrant assistance policies and programs in accordance with Government Code section 65050.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Governor's Office/Org 0500		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Private and public funds.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 65051 (b), cash donations received shall be deposited into the fund and shall be made available immediately upon deposit and appropriation by the Legislature for the purposes described above.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from donations from public and private entities.
