<u>Purpose</u> The funds will be used to construct a memorial plaque to honor the six crew members of the S. S. Baton Rouge Victory that were lost at sea on August 23, 1966. The funds would come from private donations.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of General Services/ Org 1760		
<u>Major Sources</u> Donations from private contributions.		
<u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u> Construction of a memorial plaque in honor of the crew members lost at sea from the S. S. Baton Rouge Victory when the vessel was sunk by hostile action on August 23, 1966.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Continuously appropriated without regard to fiscal year.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from donations from private contributions.		
<u>Historical Comments</u> Chapter 258, Statutes of 2004, section 1 (SB 1651) abolishes this fund effective January 1, 2005.
