<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To cover operational expenses of the California Underground Facilities Safe Excavation Board (Board) and to fund outreach and education programs that encourage safe excavation practices in accordance with Government Code section 4216 through 4216.24.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Forestry and Fire Protection/Org 3540		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Money collected as result of penalties imposed pursuant to Government Code section 4216.6 (f).		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon Appropriation by the Legislature		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> The Board administers and enforces provisions of the Dig Safe Act of 2016.
