<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To implement and administer the No Place Like Home Program (Program) in accordance with Welfare and Institutions Code section 5849.1 through 5849.14. The Program is designed to reduce homelessness and provide affordable housing for individuals with mental illness.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Housing and Community Development/Org 2240		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Any proceeds from the issuance of bonds by the State Treasurer’s Office for implementing the Program.</li> <li>2. Any other federal or state grant, or from any private donation or grant.</li> <li>3. Any interest payment, loan repayments, or other return of funds.</li> </ol>		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Notwithstanding Government Code section 13340, this fund is continuously appropriated.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from bond proceeds.
