<u>Purpose</u> For the purpose of purchasing in certain instances AIDS vaccine, as specified.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Health Services/Org 4260		
<u>Major Revenue Sources</u> Future appropriations through the state budget.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> The State of California will guarantee the purchase, within three years after the FDA approves marketing of an AIDS vaccine, of at least 500,000 units, at a cost of no more than twenty dollars (\$20) per dosage, as specified.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Section 199.51 of the Health and Safety Code provides that the State Department of Health Services is authorized to carry out this section, when such funds are appropriated through the state budget.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded - The revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> This fund was abolished pursuant to Government Code section 13306(b), effective July 23, 2011.
