<u>Purpose</u> This fund will be used to deposit violation assessments fees from Fish and Game Code section 12002 and Harbors and Navigation Code section 668. The monies will be used for the support of the Delta Protection Commission commencing in the 1992-93 fiscal year not to exceed \$250,000 per year.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Delta Protection Commission/Org 3840		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Penalty assessments for violation of Fish and Game Code 12002 and Harbors and Navigation Code 668. Legislation also provides for a loan of not more than \$250,000 from the California Environmental License Plate Fund, to be repaid by December 31, 1998, for organizational costs of the commission.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Upon abolishment, any loaned funds remaining will be transferred to the California Environmental License Plate Fund, and any other balance will, in absence of any other language, be transferred to the General Fund pursuant to Government Code section 16346.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> This fund is available upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> The Commission was originally set for abolishment on January 1, 1997. Governor delegated authority to the Department of Conservation.
