<u>Legal Title</u> Community College Faculty and Staff Development Fund		
<u>Legal Citation/Authority</u> Chapter 973, Statutes of 1988 Education Code section 87150		
<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>GAAP Basis</u> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>Legal Basis</u> Governmental/Other Governmental Cost Funds	
<u>Purpose</u> This fund is a depository for funds appropriated for the purpose of supporting locally developed and implemented faculty and staff development programs.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Board of Governors, California Community Colleges/Org 6870		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Annual appropriation from the General Fund to the board of governors who shall allocate these funds to community college districts on a per average daily attendance (ADA) basis, using the funded ADA levels for the 1987-88 fiscal year, and so that each district receives at least five thousand dollars (\$5,000).		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> For the purpose of providing state general funds to each community college district whose chief executive office has met specified requirements for supporting locally developed and implemented faculty and staff development programs.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Section 87154 of the Education Code provides that this article shall be operative during any fiscal year only if funds are provided therefor in the annual Budget Act for that fiscal year or other legislation.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded —Revenues in this fund are transferred from Fund 0001 General Fund, which is an included fund, and should not be double counted.		
<u>Comments/ Historical Information</u> This fund is abolished per Government Code section 13306(b) effective October 22, 2010.
