<b><u>Legal Title</u></b> California State Fair Police Special Account

<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>GAAP Basis</u></b> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>Legal Basis</u></b> Governmental/General Fund Special Accounts	
<b><u>Purpose</u></b> Costs of law enforcement, training of personnel and safety equipment for marshals and police appointed as peace officers for the State Fair. Money transferred from counties representing 50 percent of all fines and forfeitures collected during the preceding month upon conviction or upon the forfeitures of bail from any person arrested or notified by marshals or police and charged with a violation that occurred on the grounds or premises of the California Exposition and State Fair or any other property under the control of the California Exposition and State Fair.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> California Exposition and State Fair/Org 8560		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Fines and forfeitures from violations occurring on State fairgrounds.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Section 1463.15 of the Penal Code provides that money is available for expenditure upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from fines and penalties.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 90, Statutes of 1991, Section 45 abolished this fund.
