<u>Purpose</u> This Fund was administratively created to separate General Fund revenues from student fees collected by the California State Universities.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> California State University/Org 6610		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Student fees and other miscellaneous receipts		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> These funds are available upon appropriation by the Legislature through the Budget Act		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to provide direct services or products to the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Fund was abolished per Government Code section 13306(b) on December 17, 2012.
