<u>Purpose</u> To aid and assist veterans under the Veterans' Farm and Home Purchase Act of 1974 in accordance with Military and Veterans Code section 1000.1 through 1006.16.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Veterans Affairs/Org 8955		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Proceeds from the sale of debentures.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon appropriation)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Money may be withdrawn in accordance with law upon requisition of the department for the purpose of carrying out the Veterans' Farm and Home Purchase Act of 1974.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded —Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Public Service Enterprise Fund.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 663, Statutes of 1976 substituted Act of 1974 for Act of 1943. February 2012 revision changed the administering agency organization code from 8955 to 8950. August 2014 revision changed the administering agency organization code from 8950 to 8955.
