<b><u>Purpose</u></b> This fund is a depository for any appropriations made to the Department of Mental Health to support the development of resources and systems in solving locally identified problems relating to the mentally disabled.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Mental Health/Org 4440		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Budget Act appropriations		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> To support the development of resources and systems in solving the locally identified problems in serving the priority populations of the mentally ill for the purposes established annually in the Budget Act.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Section 5726 of the Welfare and Institutions Code provides that the Fund shall be funded from any appropriations made for the specified purposes.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Non-Federal).		
<b><u>Comments/ Historical Information</u></b> This fund was abolished with Chapter 89, Statutes of 1991, section 175.
