<u>Purpose</u> To establish a systematic program to conduct research regarding the cause, cure, and prevention of ovarian cancer. The outcome of this research may have direct effects on and consequences for the development of a comprehensive system that may identify the cause of, means of preventing, and cure for, ovarian cancer, as well as improving the screening, diagnosis, and treatment of victims of ovarian cancer. This program shall award grants to eligible physicians, hospitals, laboratories, educational institutions, and other organizations and persons for the purpose of enabling those entities and persons to conduct research.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> University of California/Org 6440		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Individual taxpayer contributions designated on their tax returns.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Fund abolished per Revenue and Taxation Code section 18797.5 (b) (2)
