<b><u>Purpose</u></b> Moneys are used to fund the nonfederal share of Whole Person Care (WPC) pilot payments as authorized under the Medi-Cal 2020 Demonstration Project. The WPC Pilot program supports local and regional efforts to integrate systems and improve care provided to Medi-Cal’s most high-risk beneficiaries.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Moneys that a participating government agency or entity elects to transfer pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 14184.60 (h) (2).		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Notwithstanding Government Code section 13340, moneys deposited in this fund are continuously appropriated without regard to fiscal years.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is intergovernmental transfers to a Trust and Agency Fund.
