<u>Purpose</u> Moneys are used as the source for the nonfederal share of Global Payment Program (GPP) payments as authorized under the Medi-Cal 2020 Demonstration Project. The GPP streamlines funding sourcing for care for California’s remaining uninsured population and creates a value-based mechanism to increase incentives to provide primary and preventive care services and other high-value services.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Moneys that a designated public hospital or affiliated government agency or entity elects to transfer pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 14184.40 (f) (2).		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Notwithstanding Government Code section 13340, moneys deposited in this fund are continuously appropriated without regard to fiscal years.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is intergovernmental transfers to a Trust and Agency Fund.
