**Amendment to Various Budget Bill Items, Support, Department of Consumer Affairs**

**Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA) (Issue 002)**—It is requested that various items be increased by an aggregate amount of \$23,248,000 from various special funds in fiscal year 2015-16 to provide funding for Boards and Bureaus within DCA to pay their pro-rated costs for the continuation of the BreEZe information technology project. Increased position authority of 29.8 positions in 2015-16 is also requested to assist with BreEZe implementation and to take over maintenance and operations of the system upon the project vendor's departure. See Attachment A for a detailed list of items impacted by these requested changes.

This request will allow DCA to move forward with a redesigned implementation plan for Release 2 Boards and Bureaus, a redesigned maintenance and operations plan for the project, and to fund credit card convenience fees on behalf of licensees who wish to make online payments. These project changes are consistent with costs identified in Special Project Report (SPR) 3.1.

Of the Boards and Bureaus included in this request, 19 were scheduled for Release 3, which is currently de-scoped from the project. These Boards and Bureaus have contributed minimal amounts toward the costs of initial hardware, software licenses, organizational change management, and additional information services positions at DCA. These initial investments will support the future integration of the Boards and Bureaus scheduled for Release 3 and they will be able to utilize much of the system design documentation written for Release 1 and Release 2. The DCA will be working on a plan to integrate the Boards and Bureaus that were scheduled for Release 3 after Releases 1 and 2 have stabilized.

Due to project delays, BreEZe's projected full system acceptance date has moved from October 2013 to June 2016. Because of this, it is requested that Provision 2 of Item 1111-002-0702, which requires project reporting to the Legislature at the conclusion of the BreEZe project, but no later than October 1, 2015, be amended to require reporting no later than June 1, 2017 to match the projected Post-Implementation Evaluation Report date. See Attachment B for revised Budget Bill language that reflects this change.

Per the Legislature's conditional approval of the Control Section 11.00 request on March 24, 2015, DCA will provide timely and relevant project updates related to Releases 1 and 2, a plan for Release 3 including anticipated project schedule and costs, and copies of DCA's status reports on implementation of the State Auditor's recommendations.

**Amendment to Budget Bill Items 2240-001-0245 and 2240-001-0648, Support,  
Department of Housing and Community Development**

It is requested that Items 2240-001-0245 and 2240-001-0648 be increased by \$381,000 and 3.2 positions and \$571,000 and 4.8 positions, respectively, to provide the Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) funding for 8 additional positions. This will enable HCD to issue building permits and perform construction inspections for manufactured home parks under the California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) Mobilehome Park Utility Upgrade Program. The Commission established a three-year pilot program, beginning on January 1, 2015 through December 17, 2017, to convert park-owned utility systems to public utility systems. HCD's role is to enforce uniform statewide standards to ensure the health and safety of mobilehome park owners, residents, and users.
