<u>Purpose</u> A for funds received for the improvement and automation of the processing of local vital record systems and vital records maintained by the State Registrar.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> State Registrar (Department of Health Services)/Org 4260		
<u>Major Sources</u> Fees or charges for a record search or for the issuance of any certificate, permit, registration, or other documents, as specified.		
<u>Disposition of Funds (upon abolishment)</u> The moneys in the fund shall be utilized by the State Registrar to improve and automate the processing of vital records maintained by the State Registrar.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Section 10040 of the Health and Safety Code provides that the money in the fund shall, upon appropriation by the Legislature, be allocated by the State Registrar to be utilized as specified.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded.		
<u>Historical Comments</u> Chapter 492, Statutes of 1994, renamed the fund as the State Vital Record Improvement Account and placed it within the Health Statistics Special Fund. The moneys in the account are to be used to improve and automate the processing of vital records maintained by the State Registrar. Abolished on January 1, 1997 per Section 102250 of the Health and Safety Code, as amended by Chapter 197, Statutes of 1996.
