<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>GAAP Basis</u></b> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<b><u>Fund Classification</u></b> <b><u>Legal Basis</u></b> Nongovernmental/Trust and Agency Funds – Non-Federal	
<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To support the Carl Moyer Memorial Air Standards Attainment Program that will substantially reduce emissions of oxides of nitrogen and fine particulate in California.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Air Resources Board/Org 3900		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Transfer from Budget Items specified in Health and Safety Code section 44299(a) and interest earned on money in the trust fund.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – The major revenue source is transferred from various funds which have already been counted or will be counted, General Fund (I) (0001), Air Pollution Control Fund (O) (0115), Diesel Emission Reduction Fund (O) (0314), and Energy Resources Programs Account (E) (0416), and should not be double counted.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> This fund is abolished per Government Code section 13306(b), effective October 22, 2010.
