**BILL SUMMARY: Energy: Alternative Fuels**

This bill would provide funding under the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program to offset costs associated with installing residential electric vehicle charging stations for homeowners who purchase electric vehicles.

This bill also makes a technical clarification.

**FISCAL SUMMARY**

There would be no fiscal impact resulting from this bill.

**COMMENTS**

Finance is neutral on this bill because the proposed language would only serve to clarify existing statutory authority. Existing law under Health and Safety Code Sections 44272(d)(1) and 44272(d)(5) already includes home charging systems for funding out of the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program. Therefore, the addition of this language will not result in any programmatic changes or additional authority for the program to provide funding.
