**BILL SUMMARY: Solid waste: carpet stewardship**

This bill would add an implementation date of January 1, 2014 to existing statute requiring the Department of General Services (DGS) to ensure postconsumer carpet removed from state facilities is recycled.

**FISCAL SUMMARY**

The DGS indicates that this bill will have no fiscal impact as Chapter 681, Statutes of 2010 (AB 2398, Perez) currently requires the DGS to ensure carpet removed from state buildings is recycled and the DGS has implemented the provisions of the chaptered legislation.

**COMMENTS**

The Department of Finance is opposed to this bill as it is unnecessary to specify an implementation date for a program that has already been implemented.

Existing law requires the DGS to ensure postconsumer carpet removed from state facilities is recycled.

This measure requires recycling of postconsumer carpet begin on or before January 1, 2014 and specifies that "state buildings" includes buildings owned or leased by the state. The DGS indicates the recycling program is current being implemented.
