BILL SUMMARY: Employment of infants: entertainment industry.

This bill would clarify that a certification of health from a physician is required prior to issuing a temporary entertainment work permit for an infant. This bill would also make other technical changes.

FISCAL SUMMARY

This bill would not result in any additional cost to the state because it merely codifies the existing practice of the Department of Industrial Relations.

COMMENTS

The Department of Finance is neutral on this bill because it provides clarification to the law regarding temporary entertainment work permits for infants.

Existing law requires an entertainment work permit, issued by the Labor Commissioner, be obtained prior to the employment of a minor in the entertainment industry. Existing law also enables a minor's parent or guardian to obtain a temporary permit for the employment of a minor under specified conditions.

This bill would clarify that, consistent with a regular entertainment minor work permit, a written certification from a physician certifying the health of an infant is required prior to issuance of a temporary permit. Additionally, this bill would fix a technical error to correctly identify the Entertainment Work Permit Fund.
