**BILL SUMMARY: Peace officers: mutual aid.**

This bill would authorize the City of Tulelake, California to enter into a mutual aid agreement with the City of Malin, Oregon, once the agreement is reviewed and approved by the Commissioner of the California Highway Patrol (CHP).

**FISCAL SUMMARY**

The CHP indicates that any costs resulting from this bill would be minor and absorbable within existing resources.

**COMMENTS**

The Department of Finance is neutral on this bill because it would provide the Cities of Tulelake, California and Malin, Oregon flexibility in providing mutual aid to their respective cities.

Existing law authorizes the CHP to enter into reciprocal operational agreements with authorized representatives of the Oregon State Police, the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety, and the Arizona Department of Public Safety to provide law enforcement assistance between these members. Existing law also states that any regularly employed law enforcement officer of these entities may act as a peace officer in California, subject to certain conditions.

This bill would authorize Tulelake, California and Malin, Oregon to enter into a mutual aid agreement for the purposes of providing law enforcement assistance as needed. The agreement must be reviewed and approved by the CHP prior to execution.
