BILL SUMMARY: Gambling Control: Key Employee Licenses

This bill would authorize a key employee with a valid personal portable license to work as a key employee in any key employee positions in more than one gambling establishment.

FISCAL SUMMARY

The California Gambling Control Commission indicates that there would be insignificant one-time costs to the Gambling Control Fund in 2011-12 to amend regulations and to make changes to the Licensing Information System.

COMMENTS

The Department of Finance is neutral on this bill.

The Gambling Control Act provides for the licensure of certain individuals and establishments involved in various gambling activities, and for the regulation of those activities, by the California Gambling Control Commission. Existing law also provides that a key employee license entitles the holder to work in any key employee position at any gambling establishment, provided that the key employee terminates employment with one gambling establishment before commencing work for another. This bill would authorize a key employee with a valid personal portable license to work as a key employee in any key employee positions in more than one gambling establishment.
