BILL SUMMARY: Sex Offenders: Registration

This bill would provide that for sex offenses similar to specified California sex offenses, there is no registration requirement unless the out-of-state sex offense, based on the elements of the conviction offense or proven or stipulated facts in the record of conviction, contains all of the elements of the specified California sex offense.

FISCAL SUMMARY

According to the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and the Department of Justice this measure would have no fiscal impact on their programs.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Amendments to this bill since our analysis of the April 7, 2011 version are minor and do not alter our position.

COMMENTS

The Department of Finance is neutral on this measure.

Existing law generally requires persons convicted of enumerated sex offenses to register within five working days of coming into a city or county, with specified law enforcement officials in the city, county or city and county where he or she resides. Existing law also requires sex offender registration, except as specified, for "any person who would be required to register while residing in the state of conviction for a sex offense committed in that state."

This bill would provide that for sex offenses similar to specified California sex offenses, there is no registration requirement unless the out-of-state sex offense, based on the elements of the conviction offense or proven or stipulated facts in the record of conviction, contains all of the elements of the specified California sex offense.
